PETITION TO THE GOVERNMENT OF CANADA

Whereas convicted murderers can have a parole hearing every two years after they reach their parole eligibility date;

Whereas families of homicide do not get parole from their suffering;

Whereas repeated parole hearings can have tremendous negative affects of families of homicide victims;

Whereas the Government of Canada promised to address the imbalance between the rights of victims and the rights of offender;

We call upon the federal Minister of Public Safety and Minister of Justice to amend the *Criminal Code of Canada* and *Corrections and Conditional Release Act* to stipulate that convicted murders should only have parole hearings every five years after reaching their parole eligibility dates.
